

ALLA Distinguished Career Award*

The Association of Latina and Latino Anthropologists (ALLA) invites nominations for the ALLA Distinguished Career Award. This prize recognizes the awardee's outstanding contributions to the field of Latina/o anthropology. A distinguished career is demonstrated through one's record of research and publication, teaching, service to ALLA/AAA, as well as one's commitment to public engagement, such as community, activist and policy efforts that serve to enhance broad-based understandings of Latina/o lives and communities in the United States.

Nominations require: a letter detailing the nominee's achievements in scholarship, service, teaching and engagement; a letter of support from a colleague in support of the nominee; up to three publications; and any other materials that best exemplify the nominee's distinguished career. ALLA encourages self-nominations for this award.

Nominations and all supporting materials should be sent electronically to each of the committee members by June 15, 2016.
